To ensure that team coaches are fully trained and prepared for the 2020 North American Indigenous Games (NAIG) environment, the following standards have been established, at a domestic level, for all coaches registered in the NAIG.

- 1. Head Coaches Fully certified under the National Coaching Certificate Program to the equivalent in the new NCCP Competition Stream, Development Context (Trained Status) and having trained status with the Aboriginal Coaching Manual (ACM).
- 2. Assistant Coaches Same as coach.

Selection will be completed by the ASRNB's 2020 Team NB Coach / Manager Selection Committee. The Coach / Manager shall provide leadership to the both their individual teams and the overall contingent that compose Team New Brunswick. The Coach / Manager will be required to establish a vision ensuring their team works towards a common goal and set a high ethical standard.

* Successful candidates will be required to obtain a Criminal Background Check and complete the Aboriginal Coaches Module workshop within the allotted timeframe.

* Final sport selection for Team New Brunswick will be based interest in sport and strength of team and must fit with NB allocation of 125 participants.

Aboriginal Sport and Recreation New Brunswick and the North American Indigenous Games Council has a strict zero-tolerance policy when it comes to drugs, alcohol and tobacco. As a coach / manager I will be responsible for our youth and if I am in violation of this policy I will be relieved of my duties and required to cover the transportation costs from Halifax. I will also be required to turn in each piece of the Team NB uniform.
